2. LOOP TECHLINE ERASER (LP-439)

The **Eraser** is your heavy-duty "eraser" in a can. It is a **multipurpose, extra-strong solvent** explicitly formulated to act as an aggressive *Paint Remover*.

- **Primary Purpose:** It is engineered to **dissolve and completely strip away** pre-existing paint, clean stubborn tools heavily encrusted with old dried layers of color, or prepare raw surfaces by eradicating old residues of resins, primers, and varnishes.
- **When to Use It:** If you made a major mistake or overspray that needs immediate correction, if you need to entirely clean a metallic or plastic surface back to its original raw state, or if you need to remove peeling layers of old paint before applying a fresh primer coat.
- **In Summary:** Raw breaking power, complete paint removal, and deep surface stripping.

 **PRO TIP:** Always keep in mind that the Eraser works by aggressively breaking down the chemical bonds of the paint. If you accidentally spray it over a freshly completed artwork to fix a tiny

detail, you risk completely dissolving the entire layer of color underneath! For fine details and sharp crisp lines, rely entirely on specialized caps and pressure control; use the Cleaner to clean your hands, gear, and workstation.
